New Principal Guest Director Rachel Podger directs Tafelmusik in a new album that explores Haydn Symphonies 43 & 49

- Set for release on October 11, 2024, this album features Haydn's symphonies No. 43 in E-flat Major Hob. I:43 "Mercury" and No. 49 in F minor Hob. I:49 "La Passione," recorded live from concerts at Toronto's Jeanne Lamon Hall in 2023.
- In a departure from traditional conductor-led recordings, Podger leads the orchestra as first violinist, presenting Haydn's symphonies in a new light.
- "Acting as a true expanded chamber music ensemble, Canada's Tafelmusik (led from the first violin by Rachel Podger) explores two Haydn symphonies with the nimbleness and spontaneity that only an ensemble without a conductor can pull off." - Tafelmusik
- "The live concerts with Tafelmusik felt like a homecoming exciting but yet easy, like a team of friends that had always belonged together. There is this shared musical language, a desire to create and go on an adventure together which we hope can be felt in this recording. - Tafelmusik has been praised by Gramophone for "determined beauty to their sweetly rich, gently vibrating sound ... precision and poetry come wonderfully together", and the combination of Tafelmusik and Podger has been described as an "intoxicating combination of power and grace" by the Toronto Star.
